Qualifications:

1. The applicant must be an account holder of the credit union for at least 6 months.
2. The scholarships are to be used for university or technical training (nursing and business school included), preferably Saskatchewan institutions. However, other universities or technical schools will be considered.
3. **Four** \$1,000.00 regional scholarships will be available. Regions are divided geographically with the 1st region being Arcola, Kennedy and Kipling the 2nd region being Glenavon, Montmartre and Odessa the 3rd region being Vibank, Riceton and Emerald Park and the 4th region being Qu'appelle, Sintaluta and Indian Head. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic excellence and good citizenship. This means continuous application to schoolwork as well as the contribution made to school and community. It is necessary to give a detailed summary of all activities in school and community. This summary should include past as well as present involvements. Student must include a copy of your latest marks including classes currently enrolled in.
4. Applications will be available at each of the schools in Kennedy, Kipling, Montmartre, Vibank, Milestone, Indian Head, Balgonie and Arcola, at anyone of Plainsview's branches or on our website at www.plainsview.com. The final decision on the awarding of the scholarship will be made by an internal committee from the credit union board of directors.
5. **Deadline for applications is April 17, 2010.**
6. Scholarships will not necessarily be awarded if none of the applicants meet the specified requirements.
7. Upon presentation, by the recipient, of a confirmation of enrolment at a university or technical school, the scholarship will be advanced. The scholarship must be advanced within the year it has been awarded.

Instructions

1. Resume is to be typed or clearly written in black ink, so it can be easily reproduced.
2. Information should be presented in a concise and orderly fashion. I.e. chronological order by area of involvement with the most recent information listed first.
3. You should provide a brief description of any clubs, groups, organizations, etc. (i.e. SRC, 4-H, church, part-time work, etc.) In which you are involved. What the group achieved and, most important, what part you played, time you invested in working with the group and what you contributed to the group=s success.
4. On an individual level you should include:
 - A) Any individual achievements over the past years and how you achieved them
 - B) How and why you chose your particular area of post-secondary study.
 - C) What your future goals and ambitions are
5. Applications must be filed with the credit union no later than April 17, 2010. They can be dropped off at any branch or mailed to Plainsview Credit Union, Attn: Tana Torkelson; Box 150, Kipling, SK S0G 2S0
6. A transcript of your latest marks should be attached including classes currently enrolled in.
